ADJOURNMENT: Mr. Kuebler made a motion, supported by Mr. Cunningham, to adjourn at 8:12p.m.

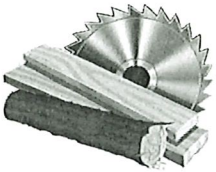

From: LuAnne Kozma, Hayes Township resident

I looked through the Parks and Recreation Committee's minutes from the past four meetings and I see you are still making plans for four expensive pickle ball courts for Camp Sea Gull—thinking that you are the decision-makers—and without any reliable documentation from the community or a professionally done survey, that demonstrates that pickle ball is what our community desires most.

This Committee has no legal authority to set any priorities or make decisions for the parks. Only the Board of Trustees can. This Committee can only make recommendations and advise. It does not administer a budget and therefore cannot "request" a budget item.

Such a survey should be this committee's top *recommendation* to the Board of Trustees. The Community Recreation and Park Plan is not even in the written duties of the Advisory Committee. Julie, the plan should be referred to the Board and to the Planning Commission for review and updating, unless the Board already asked the Committee to advise on its re-drafting.

The Board does have reliable data that the community prioritized a designated swim area at the park. Without it, swimming at Camp Sea Gull is unsafe and illegal. The Board enacted a Parks Ordinance that is the law, that requires swimmers to swim in the designated swim area at Camp Sea Gull and boats to stay out. But the Township Board does not provide that safety zone.

The only Community Recreation and Parks Plan approved by the Board of Trustees, although now expired for purposes of DNR grant eligibility, identified a designated swim area as a top priority for the park. The Board even passed a resolution for its enactment.

I've appeared before the parks committee and to Board meetings urging the installation of a designated swim area. Recommend to the Board that it be done this year. Before someone gets injured or dies here in Lake Charlevoix.

The Township is also legally required to abide by the grant contract with the DNR, which is to provide water access and the swimming area, as well as the station for the bike trail. Those are the documented and contractual priorities. Putting pickleball prior to that, is wrong and wastes taxpayers dollars. Thank you.

Shelly,

We received your email. You mention "improvements" we are making to Hayes Township Park Camp Sea Gull that you consider 'out of line'. What specifically are you referring to?

Lake Charlevoix is available for guests to swim at their leisure. Eastern Avenue Beach is a sandy swim beach also off of Lake Charlevoix (that also has several picnic tables) that is an alternative option for guests to enjoy. We are, as you mentioned, working toward a playground at Camp Sea Gull, which we think will be a great amenity for our younger guests.

You had attended a Parks and Recreation meeting and shared your views with our committee last fall. We all felt our conversation was calm and reasonable and quite lovely. Our committee members worked to clear up misinformation that had been shared with you, and we were very forthcoming with our plans. I understand that time has passed and some details may have escaped your memory, but I do feel it is very important to clarify an erroneous detail you have mentioned in several communications.

We submitted a SPARKS grant request for \$326,000.00 for Pickle Ball courts and picnic area in the park. This submission included all the bells and whistles of the absolute highest priced plan we had available for this project. The committee had no intention of ever spending that amount on the courts without that specific grant. Unfortunately, we were not awarded this grant. Plan B for the project is fundraising. We will be fundraising to raise money for this park project, which should come in around \$130-150K. Even though I don't personally play Pickle Ball, there are many people in our community who enjoy this booming sport and are excited about the prospect of having this in our park.

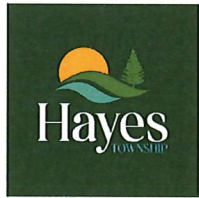
