We received final approval of safety issues from our Risk Assessor (from our township insurance) and, the park opened to the public on October 21, 201.

Fencing, both temporary and permanent, have been placed in several areas of the park to address safety concerns. Signage and safety features have been installed at the fishing pier, as well as additional safety railings

We want to thank everyone for their patience and support. We will be addressing all remaining safety concerns with our Consulting Engineers and put permanent safety features in place this spring. The bathrooms and launch will be closed for the season once the snow begins to fall, and the park roads will not be plowed. Watch for updates and signs at the entrance of the park.

We anticipate the park being fully open for the 2020 season.

Please be safe during all ice fishing activity in this area over the winter.

Winter Property Tax Payments-Address and Information

Please check to make sure you/your bank has the correct mailing address on file for property tax payments.

The correct address is: **9195 Old US 31 N, Charlevoix, MI 49720**. If a payment is received late because of an incorrect address, you are still responsible for all interest and penalties. Thank you!

Residents have several options to pay their property taxes: you can mail a check into the township hall, pay in person during office hours, pay on-line through the PSN (Payment Service Network) link on our website, or drop your payment off in our secure drop box in the circle drive of the hall.

Election Workers Needed

During an election, the township requires a staff of paid workers to work the polls. Precinct inspectors are paid to assist voters at the polls on Election Day. Registered voters interested in service as election inspectors must submit and application to their local clerk. For applications, please stop by the township or visit: www.michigan.gov/documents/ElecInspec-App1.

A precinct inspector must be a registered voter of the state and cannot be a challenger, candidate, member of a candidate's immediate family, or a member of the local Board of Canvassers. Election inspectors are needed from both major political parties.

Please consider applying to work at the election polls.
