| The following is for informational purposes only: The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2020 is 1.52 mills (\$1.52 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a 0 mill net increase over the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty (20) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 1.83 mills (\$1.83 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 18.5079 mills (\$18.5079 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Charlevoix Public Schools, Charlevoix and Antrim Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 4 years, 2021 to 2024, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2021 is approximately \$8,431,171 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2020 tax levy)? Charlevoix Public Schools Bonding Proposal Shall Charlevoix Public Schools, Charlevoix and Antrim Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of: remodeling, equipping and re-equipping, and furnishing and refurbishing school buildings; acquiring and installing instructional technology and instructional technology equipment for school buildings; purchasing school buses; and equipping, developing and improving athletic fields, athletic facilities, and sites? The following is for informational purposes only: The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2020 is 0.49 mill (\$0.49 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a 0.2 mill net decrease from the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is ten (10) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 0.38 mill (\$0.38 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).
