

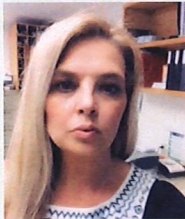

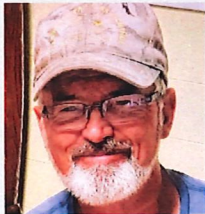

- Representatives from Reith Riley gave a presentation and shared information on their 'Green Pit' sand and gravel deposit.

- The board approved a road engineer estimate to be bid out by the road commission for work on Bay Shore West.
- The BOT approved a private road name change.

Notes from the March 2023 Advisory Group Meeting

- The group reviewed focus area 1 (Bayshore Corridor of US 31) and agreed on the changes previously discussed.
- Focus area 2, US 31 from Country Club to corner of Burgess, was reviewed. It was decided that commercial zoning on the corner of Burgess and 31 should stay commercial. A potential change would be to change light industrial zoning near Charlevoix on 31 to commercial zoning.
- Discussion on focus area 3, Lake Charlevoix waterfront, began. Mr. Iacoangeli suggested making all lots along the lake 'waterfront residential'.

Notes from March 2023 Parks and Recreation Committee Meeting

- The Parks and Recreation Committee discussed ideas for community events. Some ideas brought up were: ice cream social, swap meet, live music concert, and food trucks. Potential dates will be discussed at the April meeting. Two main 2023 goals were set. The first is removing the broken concrete from the old launch area at Hayes Township Park Camp Sea Gull. The second is getting fresh water run to the top and bottom areas of the park. Bids will be requested from local contractors for both projects for BOT review.

- The committee also decided to begin gathering information on stabilization of the shoreline at Camp Sea Gull.

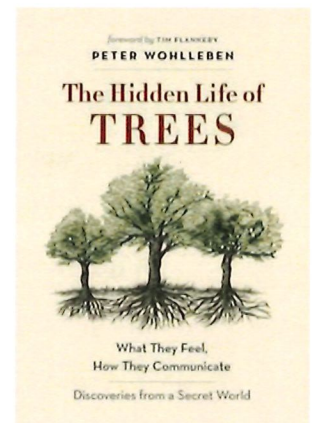

(No alcohol, liquids, or fragile food items)

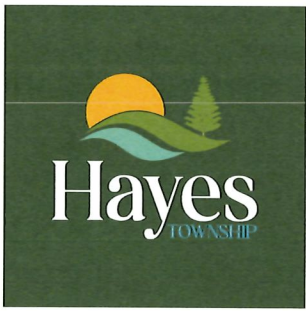
If you would like to contribute items or donate toward the purchase of items for the care packages, donations can be dropped off during Monday and Wednesday office hours.

Please have all donations to the hall by the third Monday of each month.



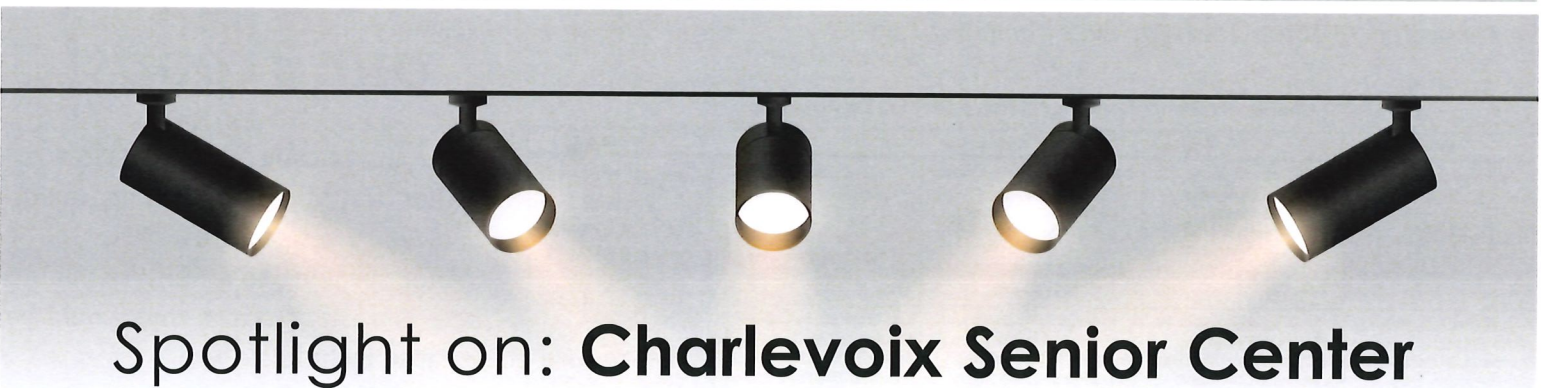

Spotlight on: **Charlevoix Senior Center**

Amy Wieland, Director of Charlevoix Commission on Aging, shared that the residents who visit the center affectionately refer to it as ‘the country club’. “The center is not just for older people,” Amy said. “All residents 60 and older are welcome. Visitors can also include their grandchildren and family members. We encourage families to be together.”

There is an extensive home care division that offers personal and respite care to qualified individuals. This includes in home foot care, respite care, home delivered meals, light housekeeping, and personal care.

In addition to the home care options, there are many monthly activities for residents to participate in. This includes, but is definitely not limited to: yoga, beginner pickleball, Veteran coffee & doughnuts, games, puzzles, foot clinic, blood pressure clinic, and cardio drumming. The seniors choose their level of engagement-if someone prefers to sit and do a puzzle, watch a movie, or listen to music by themselves, they are welcome to do that. Just getting out of their house and having a change of scenery is important.

One of the most popular Senior Center offerings are their daily meals, vetted by a registered dietician. There is a suggested donation of \$3 for seniors, \$8 for other residents, but Amy shared that no one is turned away. The center served over 500 corned beef and cabbage meals for St. Patrick’s day, and at \$3 a meal, this was the best deal in town. Meals can be enjoyed at the center or taken home.

The resources offered through the senior center are so important to our community. Amy told us, “We are changing what aging looks like in Charlevoix County. When you turn 60, come and take advantage of the services we offer. We will help people customize their own experience.”

The April 2023 Activities and Meal Calendars are printed on page 3 of this edition of the Voice. We will also be posting them online monthly and have copies available at the township hall.

The Charlevoix Senior Center is located at 13513 Division Street in Charlevoix. There are also senior centers in Boyne City, East Jordan, and Beaver Island. If you have any questions, please call 231-237-0103.
