Handling the Holidays after

The signs of the holiday season are ubiquitous: Holiday decorations in the stores, piped in Christmas carols, holiday displays at the malls, TV programs focusing on selecting the perfect gift, holiday parties and gift exchanges at

In many cases, this bustle of activity contrasts markedly with the emptiness and despairof grief.

Grief is healthy, and necessary. Grieving means we acknowledge the loss, but it doesn't mean those of us left behind can stop living until it's over. In fact, it can be viewed as a time to start new traditions, while honoring theold ones.

Dilemmas Associated with the Holiday Season:

1. The Requirement of Cheerfulness. There is an expectation during the holidays that people should be cheerful. One mourner explained that she hated going to holiday gatherings. "I could not be such a loss. Some choose to cheerful and I did not want to bring other people down by being sad.

2. The Mine Field of Social Exchanges. On many occasions, the innocent remarksof others may put a knifethrough the mourner's heart. Shortly after the death of their son, the parents attended a holiday dinner hosted by the boy's grandparents. The host began the meal with a blessing, "Thank you for bringing the whole family together." The father was so distressedby this remark that he left the

3. The Complexity of Decisions. Bereaved individualsmust navigate a difficult path in deciding how to handle decisions about family activities and rituals. As one mourner



indicated, "I was not sure whether I should hang my son's stocking or not. I decided to hang it, because after all he is my son. But my husbandthought that this was not a good idea. He told me that I was 'in denial.

4. The Ambush. During the holidays, mourners are often hit by powerful feelings that are evoked by some reminder of the loss. Consequently, they experience what Noel and Blair (2000) have called "the ambush." As one mother explained, I was taking out the Christmas ornaments and I came across an ornament that Timmy had made in kindergarten last year. It had his hand print on it. I dissolved into tears."

Although natural and normal, such experiences are often frightening in their intensity. There's no skip the holidays, which is diffi cult because we're surrounded by holiday music, messages and events.

Others try to celebratejust as if their lost loved one is still there, which can make the person's absence even more painful.

It's important to know there are local, professional resources that are capable of helping you during a painful time. Even though you didn't choose the circumstances that are leading you to grieve, you have a choice in how you respond to your grief.

Medicare: Choosing Doctors and Other Providers

Depending on your coverage, you will have different considerations when choosing health care providers like doctors, hospitals, or medical equipment suppliers. Let's review some of these factors, so you can get your care covered at the lowest cost.

Even with this information in hand, remember to trust yourself and your feelings when choosing your health care providers. For instance, just because a provider is in network doesn't mean they will be a good fit for you. You may have to try multiple providers before finding one who you trust and who fits your needs.

Protect yourself from pharmacy and prescription drug fraud, errors, and abuse.

Medicare pharmacy or prescription drug fraud occurs when Medicare is billed for a presciption that you did not receive, or if you are purposefully given a different medication than the one your doctor prescribed. Examples of suspected pharmacy or prescription drug fraud, errors, or abuse include: A provider billing Medicare for drugs you never received.

- A pharmacy providing you with expired drugs or automatically refilling a prescription you no longer need and billing Medicare.
- A pharmacy providing you with less medication than you were prescribed.
- A company offering you "free" or "discount" prescription drugs without a prescription and then billing Medicare.

Always read your Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from your prescription drug plan to make sure you recognize the names of the providers and prescriptions listed on the notice.
