We have Advanced Care Planning Sessions, Silent Book Club, Sewing & Mending groups, BI Satisfaction &

We have enhanced our Nutritional Program too! We have additional Nutritional Program Food Theme/Celebration Days & menus, New Wednesday Night Dinner Theme nights; Home Delivered 1x a week meals get 1 hot, 2 cold and 4 frozen as a new option, Soup &/or a salad will be served with every meal - Soups are Monday, Wednesday & Friday and salads are Tuesday and Thursday, we sell extra Frozen Meals and we try to meet the wants with some vegetarian options and Lent options when we can.

We have collaborated with Safe Haven to help them serve Breakfast for Free on Tuesdays and Fridays to anyone who comes to the Charlevoix Senior Center between 8a-9a. These breakfasts can be dine in or take out curbside.

We will keep you posted on upcoming meet the author events, Travel Club opportunities to get out with friends and when the adult 3 wheeled bikes will be available again.

“Consumer scams are so prevalent and sophisticated that it’s really a matter of when you become a target, not if you become one,” said Nessel. “We need to shift our thinking from identity theft recovery to identity theft prevention to minimize our risk.”
WATCH OUT FOR THESE RED FLAGS!!!

- Unfamiliar provider names and charges on your Medicare statement.
 - Notices of Medicare number compromise due to a data breach.
 - Bills from medical providers for services you did not receive.
 - Rejection of legitimate medical claims due to benefits limit reached.
 - Health plan denial due to false conditions in your medical records.
- GUARD YOUR MAIL AND PACKAGES FROM PORCH PIRATES!**
- Mail should not sit in your mailbox for an extended period.
 - If away from home, suspend your mail delivery.
 - Opt-out of credit offers arriving in your USPS mailbox.
 - Don’t leave mail for the carrier; use USPS boxes instead.
 - Use informed delivery: Digital Preview Mail.
 - Shred mail into micro pieces.
